Confirmations:

We utilize the Agility Unscrambled program which allows e-mail confirmations and results dissemination.

We will send out electronic confirmations before and electronic results after the trial.

Please make sure the e-mail address on your entry form is legible.

Food info:

It is expected all exhibitors will be working the trial, and because of this, water and light snacks will be provided each day for all exhibitors. Please **bring your personal water bottle for refilling** from our large container.

Individual water bottles will not be used at this trial. Bring your lunch as there will be no food vendor on site.

Awards and Ribbons:

Twelve inch placement ribbons will be awarded to the first four places in each jump height for each class, in each category, except Chances which is a pass/fail class. A purple qualifying ribbon shall be given for each qualifying round in each class.

Dogs cannot be officially measured before 2 years old but, must be measured by the time they are competing in Elite.

JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.

- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (zip-lock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but you cannot indicate to the dog it is there. All handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitor's Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
 - 1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
 - 1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
 - 1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
 - 1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), **Southwest Agility Team** (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and **Expo New Mexico** (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
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CURRENT COVID-19 CDC GUIDANCE and other safety considerations (subject to change):

- If you are ill, exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms or have recently been exposed to someone who has COVID-19 or who has tested positive, please stay home.
- Masking is not required at this time; however, please feel free to mask-up to your comfort level. Mask requirements could change by the date of this event, so please refer to any subsequent email announcements or updates.
- Maintaining some level of social distance from those not in your household is also recommended for you and your dog.
- Please wash your hands and use hand sanitizer regularly.

CANINE VIRUS (subject to change) please follow this guideline:

- Just like us humans with Covid, if your dog is sick or showing kennel cough type symptoms, keep them home, isolated and contact your veterinarian. Do not bring an ill dog to the trial.

SWAT reserves the right to excuse anyone or any dog who is showing signs of illness. Anyone who is excused for these reasons will NOT receive a refund.

Directions:

From I-40 East: Exit onto Louisiana Blvd. (Exit 162), and head south. Turn right (west) onto Lomas Blvd; turn left (south) onto San Pedro. From San Pedro, if you have a parking pass, enter the fairgrounds through Gate 6 (if it is open), the first gate on the left (the horse gate); otherwise, keep going south and enter through Gate 3. Once inside the fairgrounds, the Horse Arena is in the northeast corner just past the Dairy Barn.

From I-40 West, exit San Mateo south (Exit 161 A). Turn left (east) onto Lomas and right (south) onto San Pedro. See above for the rest of the directions.

Daily Parking at Expo New Mexico:

Parking on the Expo grounds requires payment.

PAID PARKING OPTIONS: Karen will not have any extra parking passes. She will only order enough passes to cover the requests for parking passes received by January 17, 2025. Please email Karen at the address below if you believe your request will not make it by the deadline.

- **Day-Of Parking:** You may choose to pay each day, one entry charge of \$10 to the grounds at Gate 3. You will **not** have in/out privileges with the daily paying at Gate 3 and it will cost you \$20 for the two days.
- **Parking Pass purchased prior to the Trial:** You may obtain prepaid parking passes through SWAT. These passes are required to enter through Gate 6 and can be used at Gate 3. The parking passes are \$15.00 for two days and allow unlimited entrance and exit to the EXPO grounds. If you want a parking pass, **you must send a check payable to SWAT, to Karen Green 301 Dartmouth Drive NE, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87106-2115.**
- Please note entrance/parking on Friday, January 31st (set-up day) is free. Just tell the person at the kiosk you are going to the dog agility trial set-up. They should not charge you.

Parking pass requests and fees **must be received by Karen Green on or before January 17, 2025,** in order to process and return parking passes to exhibitors. You must include a **Self-Addressed, Stamped Envelope** with your check. Please be sure your return envelope has a stamp on it. Exhibitors will need to watch their emails for updates or changes regarding parking, available gate access and set-up. RV Parking at Expo New Mexico:

RV Parking RV Rates-- Full Hook-up or Dry Camp (All RV parking, including location, is at the discretion of EXPO NM):

New Rate: \$60 per night with (hookups include at least one of the following: electric, water, sewer, based on availability).

New Rate: \$30 per night for dry camp, which means no amenities at all.

Here's how it works for RVs at EXPO: To reserve a spot, email Karen Green at fgreen38@comcast.net and provide the following information: name, email address, phone number, date and time of your arrival, and the number of nights you will be staying, with a description of your RV, if you will have a tow vehicle, and what services you are requesting (full hook-up or dry).

If you have attended agility trials at EXPO before and would like a 'specific' spot, please include that also. I can't promise, but I will try to get it for you.

A week prior to the trial, Karen will provide the EXPO Coordinator a list of names and contact information. The EXPO Coordinator will email you an invoice that you will pay online. If there is an error on your invoice, please contact the EXPO Coordinator directly to resolve the issue.

When you arrive, enter the fairgrounds through Gate 3: Copper and San Pedro. Go to the stop sign and pull into one of the parking lots nearby. Call the number for the 24/7 security guard, 505-401-5095. An EXPO Coordinator will meet you, take you to your site, and collect your RV fee, if you have not paid online.

Note: There are a limited number of 30 amp or 50 amp spots near the Horse Arena. Please let Karen Green know no later than **January 20, 2025.**
