Notice to Competitors

USDAA Rules Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of USDAA Rules and Regulations, including but not limited to the following rules:

- All dogs must be registered with the USDAA to compete. If your dog is NOT registered, you may go online to www.usdaa.com, click on General Information to obtain a registration number immediately and a measurement card prior to the show. You may also fill out the form located on the back of the official entry form and add the registration fee to your entry fee.
- If your dog is not registered, a registration form must be submitted with entry; PENDING is not an acceptable registration number.
- This test is open to all USDAA-registered dogs eighteen months of age and over, pure and mixed breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, and dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.
- Handlers and dogs should be familiar with USDAA equipment. Training will not be allowed.
- Safety shall be the foremost consideration in the actions and conduct of handlers.
- No training, pinch or shock collars will be permitted on or near the course at any time.
- The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the committee views that participation by competitor or dog would be prejudicial to the sport. However, any committee so doing must notify the competitor in writing (with a copy to the USDAA office) in anticipation of or upon receipt of entry. The notice must include the reason for refusing the entry and a brief explanation of the basis for their decision. The burden of responsibility for appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

Entries and Closing Date Entry closing date is Monday, March 15th at 6:00 p.m. at the trial secretary’s address. Entries sent by overnight mail must be sent “no signature required.”

Secondary closing date for advancement in level only is Monday, March 22nd at 6:00pm.

All Competitors and handlers hereby release USDAA and its representatives, agents and assigns from any claim or cause of action for invasion of the rights of privacy, right of publicity, right of personality, or any similar right.

Behavior of children and dogs Competitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and children. Any competitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show site. No refund will be made.

Refunds ● There shall be no refunds if the Test cannot be opened or completed for any cause beyond the control of the Organizing Committee, or in the event that a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for dismissal. No refunds will be made for entry fee overpayments in the amount of \$10.00 or less. A withdrawal from the trial after the Closing Date due to a dog's injury or illness will be eligible for up to 75% of the total entry fee paid; a veterinarian's notice of injury or illness will be required. Bitches that come into season after the Closing Date will be eligible for a refund for up to 75% of the total entry fee paid. **Refund requests must be received by the secretary via e-mail (krisch@yahoo.com) at least one day prior to the event.**

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$20.00 service charge for returned checks. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made in cash or money order within 30 days of postmark of notice of returned check where notification is received after event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice shall result in cancellation of event results for all classes for the registration number(s) of delinquent entry/entries. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification, or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is cancelled without recourse by owner/handler.

Competition

General Information

- This event will be held, rain or shine, outdoors on a grass field.
- Ample crating space is available in close proximity to the agility ring.
- Bring shade, chairs and water. There is no shade.
- There will be no period for equipment familiarization, although warm-up jumps will be provided.
- Fault limits may be imposed at the discretion of the organizing committee and/or the judge.

Obstacles Agility obstacles are chosen from those described in the current edition of the Official Rules and Regulations of the USDAA, Inc.

Running order

- Running order is determined by random draw.
- Change of jump heights will be made *only* when the dog is required to move into a **higher** category by the judge's measure-in. The handler can decide to run exhibition in the lower height; but no qualifying scores or awards may be earned. Otherwise, the dog will be placed first in the running order of the new jump height.
- Handlers with more than one dog in a class will be separated whenever possible.

Prizes and Awards

- First through fourth place rosettes will be awarded in each jump height for all classes, except Pairs where ribbons will be awarded to mini and open classes. A maroon qualifying ribbon will be awarded for those achieving a qualifying score in a test class.
- First through third place rosettes will be awarded in each jump height for the Grand Prix and Performance Grand Prix classes. A maroon and white ribbon will be awarded to those achieving a qualifying score in the Grand Prix, a pink and maroon ribbon will be awarded to those achieving a qualifying score in the Performance Grand Prix.
- Title ribbons will also be available.

Show Site Information

- Stay on Alameda/528 N. and it will become a "ramp" and it will still be 528 N.
- Stay on NM 528 N. and it will eventually become Rio Rancho Blvd.
- You will pass "Intel", keep going, well past "Intel" keep an eye out for High Resort Blvd. on your left.
- Turn left onto High Resort Blvd. and it will go past medical buildings and houses for a few long blocks
- High Resort Blvd. drops abruptly and you will see the Sports Complex on the right

Class Descriptions

The following titling classes are being offered at the Starters, Advanced, Masters, and Performance 1, 2, and 3 levels at this event: Jumpers, Standard, Gamblers, Pairs Relay, and Snooker. Competitors may enter a combination of Championship and Performance classes, but they may not enter a class in the same program on the same day, i.e., Standard Championship and Standard Performance. A complete description of these classes and the requirements for eligibility for entry may be found in Chapters 3-7 of the official USDAA® Rules & Regulations, which are incorporated in this test schedule by reference. A summary of eligibility requirements for all titling classes is presented in Appendix E of the Rules & Regulations.

Please note that PERFORMANCE PAIRS IS REQUIRED FOR TITLING AT ALL LEVELS. Both Championship and Performance partners must be in the same level and height division: mini Ch 12/16, Perf 8/12 OR open Ch 22/26, Perf 16/22.

For Pairs, in the event only one dog is entered in a program/level, un-entered dogs or dogs from other programs/levels may NOT be recruited to form a qualifying pair.

Tournament Classes

The following 2010 tournament **local qualifiers** are being offered at this event:

- Grand Prix of Dog Agility® World Championships
- Performance Grand PrixSM Championships
- Dog Agility Steeplechase®
- Performance Speed JumpingSM

These tournaments are open to all competitors regardless of titles earned or skill level. The tournament regulations for each tournament may be found on the USDAA web site at www.usdaa.com. Please note that if you have purchased access to the Subscriber Services area on the USDAA web site, you may print a complete copy of the regulations as included in the Subscriber Services Form & Documents Library at no charge.

2010 Grand Prix of Dog Agility® World Championships & Performance Grand PrixSM Championships Local Qualifiers

These single-round tournaments are judged under Masters rules. A dog may be entered in Grand Prix **or** Performance Grand Prix at this event but not both. Competitors earning zero (0) faults shall earn a qualifying score. The first place dog/handler in each jump height earning a qualifying score will be awarded a "bye" into the final round of the Regional Championship. One (1) qualifying score is required to enter round 1 of a Regional Championship and two (2) qualifying scores are required to enter the quarterfinals at the World Championship.

2010 Dog Agility Steeplechase® & Performance Speed JumpingSM Local Qualifiers

These 2-round tournaments are judged under Starters level rules on a **time plus faults** scoring method. A dog may be entered in Steeplechase **or** Performance Speed Jumping at this event but not both. A qualifying score (based on entries and scores that day) is earned in Round 1. In Steeplechase, one (1) qualifying score is required to enter Round 1 of a Regional Championship and two (2) qualifying scores are required to enter the quarterfinals at the World Championship. A "bye" may be earned in Round 2 of a Regional Championship. In Speed Jumping, two (2) qualifying scores are required for entry into the semifinals at the World Championships. **Steeplechase Awards:** Prize money shall be computed based upon 40% of the total entry fees to be allocated in accordance with the payout table below regardless of the size of entry in any height class. *Allocable amounts to finalist positions that are not filled for any reason or allocable prize amounts less than \$3.00 shall not be paid.*
