Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

Classes have been scheduled so that most Masters/Excellent dogs will be finished running for the day before the Open and Novice classes begin. Exhibitors should make every effort to limit their time on the trial grounds to the minimum time necessary to prepare for and complete their runs, including measuring if a VMO or AKC Rep is present. Exhibitors who volunteer to work may remain on the trial grounds. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

**Judges are not required** to wait for dogs. However, because the gate steward should not be calling exhibitors to the ring by shouting out names of handlers or dogs, and handlers waiting to

run should be exercising social distancing, leeway will be given for exhibitors to make it to the ring for their run. If an exhibitor is not present when first called, they will be allowed to move to the end of their height group and run when called again.

### MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

#### Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a section at the top of the form for the exhibitor to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs to Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

#### Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Within Same Trial Weekend Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard and JWW be either both Regular or both Preferred on the same trial day. Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple ump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day. A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend.

### DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an **AKC Canine Partners listing number**, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of register able breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

### OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place **indoors** on **dirt**. Ring size will be **100x100**.

### FIX AND GO ON (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

**Illegible entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a **\$25.00** collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

### DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

#### DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE:

**From 1-40 East:** Exit onto Louisiana Blvd. (Exit 162), and head south. Turn right (west) onto Lomas Blvd; turn left (south) onto San Pedro. From San Pedro, if you have a parking pass, enter the fairgrounds through **Gate 6**, the first gate on the left (the horse gate); otherwise, enter through Gate 3. Once inside the fairgrounds, the Horse Arena is in the northeast corner just past the Dairy Barn.

**From I-40 West,** exit San Mateo south (Exit 161 A). Turn left (east) onto Lomas and right (south) onto San Pedro. See above for the rest of the directions.

### COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Please follow the **SWAT**  
**COVID-19 Safety Measures included in this premium.**

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in

that class only. To promote sufficient social distancing, walk-through groups will consist of no more than 25 handlers.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog. Face coverings must be worn in the warm-up area; and hand sanitizer will be available for use before and after using the warm-up jump.

## RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Strip Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

### SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

**The safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

**It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Neither the [Weimaraner Club of Albuquerque](#) nor [Southwest Agility Team](#) and their agents, employees, etc., will assume any responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The [Weimaraner Club of Albuquerque](#) and [Southwest Agility Team](#) reserve the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the [Weimaraner Club of Albuquerque](#) or [Southwest Agility Team](#) or any official thereof.

**All dogs must be on leash** at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

### REFUNDS

- **No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee, except for cancellation due to COVID-19. It is possible that State government restrictions on travel into New Mexico, as well as activities and gatherings within the state, may require cancellation of this trial, or cluster of trials, after the closing date. If the trial(s) must be cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic, full refunds will be provided to all exhibitors.**
- **No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.**

- **A withdrawal from the trial after the closing date due to an injury and/or illness to the dog will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of the total entry fee paid. A veterinarian's notice of injury or illness will be required for the refund to be issued.**
- **Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund 100% per day of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason. In order to receive a refund the handler must notify the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials.**
- **A full refund will be provided to any exhibitor who chooses to withdraw their entry to these trials for any of the following reasons: The exhibitor**
  - (1) has symptoms of COVID-19,**
  - (2) has been exposed to COVID-19,**
  - (3) is concerned for their health or chance of spreading the virus, or**
  - (4) feels they are unable to abide by the COVID-19 safety measures established by SWAT for this trial.****Notice of withdrawal must be given to the trial secretary no later than 7:00 am, Friday, June 25, 2021.**
- **No refunds will be issued for any amount less than \$15.00**

### CATALOGS

A limited number of catalogs will be available for viewing at the trial secretary booth. None will be sold. Running order sheets will be available at no charge and posted online after closing with one copy posted at the trial site during the trials.

## ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

The Horse Arena is located on the campus of Expo New Mexico. It is climate controlled with a packed dirt surface. There is plenty of room for crating and lots of space for walking dogs outdoors.

**Crating/Seating:** Crating is on floors in the building lobby or side entries of the arena. Crates may be left overnight; however, WCA/SWAT and Expo New Mexico will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. Security is provided by Expo New Mexico. Doors are locked at 8 pm and opened at 6 am. No dogs may be left in the building overnight. There are bleachers available for seating.

**Exhibitors are responsible** for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds

## HOTEL AND RV INFORMATION

The Weimaraner Club makes no guarantee that these motels policy will be the same on the day of the trial. When traveling with a pet, you should always recheck the pet policy. PLEASE clean up after your dogs, do not leave them unattended in the motel room, dogs are to be quiet and under control, in crates, and please obey the individual motel rules regarding dogs.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs immediately on hotel/motel and trial grounds. Motels/hotels require that dogs be crated when unattended; no bathing or grooming of dogs in guest rooms. Exhibitors/handlers are responsible for any damages to motels/hotels or the event site and such damage may result in disciplinary action by the Trial committee. Entries may be refused in the future for previous misuse of the motel facilities. This is an AKC supported measure.

**RV Parking:** There is plenty of RV parking, and it is first-come, first-served. Note that Expo RV parking is about half a mile from the Horse Arena. **RV RATES - Full Hook-up Dry Camp (All RV parking, including location, is at the discretion of EXPO NM) \$40.00 per night with electric, water, sewer (based on availability) \$30.00 per night without hook**

**Here's how it works for RVs at Expo.** Enter the grounds through Gate 3 at Copper and San Pedro. Go to the stop sign and pull into one of the parking lots you see. Call the number for the 24/7 security guard, **505-401-5095**, and he will come and meet you, take you to your site, and take your money.

**No overnight parking** will be allowed at the trial site other than RVs

**Exhibitor Parking**

The Dairy Barn will not be available for parking. However, there is ample parking space near the arena.

All parking is paid parking.

**Day-Of Parking:** Expo allows you to purchase daily passes for \$7.50 a day if you go through the main gate (Gate 3); they will not take cash for day passes at Gate 6.

**Option to purchase parking passes prior to trial:** Exhibitors may obtain **prepaid parking passes through SWAT. These passes are required to enter through Gate 6.** The parking passes are \$14.00 for three days and allow unlimited **entrance and exit to the EXPO.** If you want a parking pass, you **must** send a check **payable to:** SWAT to **Donna Cray Johnson, 4829 Shin Ave., Rio Rancho, NM 87144.**

Southwest Agility Team (SWAT) and the Weimaraner Club of Albuquerque (WCA) have put in place preventative measures to minimize the spread of Coronavirus/Covid-19 for all of their dog agility trials, including participation as an exhibitor, spectator or as a volunteer. However, SWAT and WCA cannot guarantee that you or your families will not be exposed to or become infected with Coronavirus/COVID-19 while at SWAT/WCA trials. By signing this agreement, the undersigned acknowledges, on my behalf and on behalf of my minor child(ren) or minor child(ren) I am the legal guardian of that are listed below ("child(ren)"), the contagious nature of Coronavirus/COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that my child(ren), my dog(s) and myself may be exposed to or infected by Coronavirus/COVID19 while at a SWAT/WCA trial and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, or death. With full knowledge and appreciation of the risks outlined above, I voluntarily agree to assume all of the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to my child(ren), my dog(s), or myself (including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, and death), illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense, of any kind arising out of or relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19 exposure/infection that I, my child(ren), or my dog(s) may experience or incur in connection with our physical presence at a SWAT/WCA trial. On my behalf, and on behalf of my children listed below, I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless SWAT, its Executive Committee, members, agents, and representatives; WCA, its Board of Directors, members, agents, and representatives; and the Expo New Mexico and its board of directors, employees, members, volunteers, agents, and representatives, of and from the Claims, including all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses of any kind arising out of or thereto. I also agree to defend and indemnify the released parties for any and all claims brought by a third party which arise from my, my child(ren(s))', or my dog(s)' attendance at a SWAT/WCA Trial. I understand and agree that this release includes any Claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of SWAT, its board of directors, members, volunteers, agents, and representatives, and WCA, its board of directors, members, volunteers, agents, and representatives, whether Coronavirus/COVID-19 exposure/infection occurs before, during, or after being at a SWAT/WCA Trial. In the event SWAT and/or WCA deem it necessary to employ legal counsel to protect their rights under this agreement and the court finds in favor of SWAT and/or WCA, I agree to pay all expenses incurred by SWAT/ and/or WCA in connection with any Claim, including, but not limited to, costs and reasonable attorney's fees.

1. REFUND POLICY.
  - a. **Who should not attend:** any person who has symptoms of COVID-19, who knows or suspects they have been exposed to COVID-19, or who has tested positive within 21 days of the trial, or who is concerned for their health or that they will be unable to follow these safety measures.
  - b. REFUND: any exhibitors who have entered a SWAT trial and decide that they should not attend for any of the above reasons will be eligible for a FULL REFUND of entry fees, as long as the trial secretary is notified before 7:00 am on the first day of the trial.
2. FACE COVERINGS AND SOCIAL DISTANCING.
  - a. All exhibitors and workers/volunteers are required to wear a face mask that fully covers their nose and mouth at all times while inside the arena building.
  - b. Walk-throughs will be limited to twenty-five exhibitors at a time. Final walk-through groupings will be announced in the final confirmation letter.
  - c. Maps, gate sheets, and results will be provided to exhibitors electronically, in a manner announced in the final confirmation letter.
  - d. The Gate Steward will have a space at least 6 x 6 feet, marked by tape or ex-pen and located no closer than 6 feet from the gate. Exhibitors will not be allowed in the Gate Steward's area; only the Gate Steward will mark the gate sheets.
  - e. The Leash Runner will use a grabber to pick up leashes left at the start line. The grabber will be cleaned after each leash. Exhibitors may carry their leashes on their body or in a pocket (not carried) during their runs, however any contact with the leash by the dog during a run will result in NQ.
  - f. SWAT will provide water for exhibitors, but will not provide snacks or lunches for exhibitors or workers. Workers will be thanked with vouchers that can be used for future trials.
  - g. There will not be a food vendor at this trial, so plan to bring your own food. There is a McDonald's nearby, as well as a Smith's grocery store. Be aware of parking restrictions, however. Only those who purchase a 3-day pass will have in and out privileges; all others will have to pay for parking upon re-entry.
  - h. Ribbon stickers and ribbons will be placed on a self-serve table marked by tape so that only one person may be at the table at a time.
  - i. Warm-up jumps will not be fenced. Masks must be worn at the warm-up jumps.
3. CRATING RESTRICTIONS  
 Crating will be allowed inside the arena building. Crate set-ups will be required to be at least six feet from each other. This means that crating space will be limited.
